John 14:8-11 (NLT)

✿ (8) Philip said, "Lord, show us the Father, and we will be satisfied." (9) Jesus replied, "Have I been with you all this time, Philip, and yet you still don't know who I am? Anyone who has seen me has seen the Father! So why are you asking me to show him to you? (10) Don't you believe that I am in the Father and the Father is in me? The words I speak are not my own, but my Father who lives in me does his work through me. (11) Just believe that I am in the Father and the Father is in me. Or at least believe because of the work you have seen me do.

Matthew 14:14 (NLT)

✿ Jesus saw the huge crowd as he stepped from the boat, and he had compassion on them and healed their sick.

Luke 8:24-25 (NLT)

Luke 8:1-3 (NLT)

- ✿ *(1) Soon afterward Jesus began a tour of the nearby towns and villages, preaching and announcing the Good News about the Kingdom of God. He took his twelve disciples with him, (2) along with some women who had been cured of evil spirits and diseases. Among them were Mary Magdalene, from whom he had cast out seven demons; (3) Joanna, the wife of Cbuza, Herod's business manager; Susanna; and many others who were contributing from their own resources to support Jesus and his disciples.*

☼ *Parables*

Luke 4:42-44 (NLT)

- ☼ *(42) Early the next morning Jesus went out to an isolated place. The crowds searched everywhere for him, and when they finally found him, they begged him not to leave them. (43) But he replied, "I must preach the Good News of the Kingdom of God in other towns, too, because that is why I was sent." (44) So he continued to travel around, preaching in synagogues throughout Judea.*

Matthew 28:18-20 (NLT)

- ✿ *(18) Jesus came and told his disciples, "I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth. (19) Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations,* baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. (20) Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age."*

Luke 19:10 (NLT)

- ✿ *For the Son of Man came to seek and save those who are lost.*

Luke 6:12-13 (NLT)

- *(12) One day soon afterward Jesus went up on a mountain to pray, and he prayed to God all night. (13) At daybreak he called together all of his disciples and chose twelve of them to be apostles. Here are their names:*

Luke 5:29-32 (ESV)-The parable (proverb) of the Doctor/Physician

- (29) *And Levi made him a great feast in his house, and there was a large company of tax collectors and others reclining at table with them. (30) And the Pharisees and their scribes grumbled at his disciples, saying, "Why do you eat and drink with tax collectors and sinners?" (31) And Jesus answered them, "Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick. (32) I have not come to call the righteous but sinners to repentance."*

Luke 15:4-7 (NLT)- The parable of the Lost Sheep

- (4) *"If a man has a hundred sheep and one of them gets lost, what will he do? Won't he leave the ninety-nine others in the wilderness and go to search for the one that is lost until he finds it? (5) And when he has found it, he will joyfully carry it home on his shoulders. (6) When he arrives, he will call together his friends and neighbors, saying, 'Rejoice with me because I have found my lost sheep.' (7) In the same way, there is more joy in heaven over one lost sinner who repents and returns to God than over ninety-nine others who are righteous and haven't strayed away!"*

Luke 15:8-10 (NLT) - The parable of the Lost Coin

☀ (8) "Or suppose a woman has ten silver coins* and loses one. Won't she light a lamp and sweep the entire house and search carefully until she finds it? (9) And when she finds it, she will call in her friends and neighbors and say, 'Rejoice with me because I have found my lost coin.' (10) In the same way, there is joy in the presence of God's angels when even one sinner repents."

Luke 15:11-32

☀ *The prodigal son*

Luke 5:34-39 (ESV)- New Cloth/New Wine

- ✿ (34) And Jesus said to them, "Can you make wedding guests fast while the bridegroom is with them? (35) The days will come when the bridegroom is taken away from them, and then they will fast in those days." (36) He also told them a parable: "No one tears a piece from a new garment and puts it on an old garment. If he does, he will tear the new, and the piece from the new will not match the old. (37) And no one puts new wine into old wineskins. If he does, the new wine will burst the skins and it will be spilled, and the skins will be destroyed. (38) But new wine must be put into fresh wineskins. (39) And no one after drinking old wine desires new, for he says, 'The old is good.'"

John 3:26-29 (NLT)

- ✿ (26) So John's disciples came to him and said, "Rabbi, the man you met on the other side of the Jordan River, the one you identified as the Messiah, is also baptizing people. And everybody is going to him instead of coming to us." (27) John replied, "No one can receive anything unless God gives it from heaven. (28) You yourselves know how plainly I told you, 'I am not the Messiah. I am only here to prepare the way for him.' (29) It is the bridegroom who marries the bride, and the best man is simply glad to stand with him and hear his vows. Therefore, I am filled with joy at his success.

Luke 5:36-39 (ESV)- New Cloth/New Wine

- ✿ *(34) And Jesus said to them, "Can you make wedding guests fast while the bridegroom is with them?
